The Amateur Entomologists' Society Bug Club and the Oxford University Museum of Natural History are inviting young entomologists to join us in a day of insect talks and activities.

You will have an opportunity to give a talk, visit the insect collections and meet with other young entomologists at Oxford University's famous Museum of Natural History.

In addition to behind-the-scenes tours of the Hope Entomological Collections, there will be insect related activities, including opportunities to cuddle a cockroach and tickle a tarantula.

Information displays will also be on hand about the Bug Club, National Insect Week events in 2012.

Children (any age below 18) are invited to give a short talk on an insect related topic. The talks will be judged by a panel of experts, and prizes will be awarded for the best presentations, taking into account the age of the presenter.
