We are pleased to inform you that the 2008 Annual Exhibition will be held at Kempton Park Racecourse, Staines Road, Sunbury, on Saturday 18th October 2008. The event, the largest invertebrate fair of the year, will once again utilise the ground and first floor halls of the venue and will have something of interest for anyone with a fascination of invertebrates.

We would like to invite all members to display an exhibit at the event. We welcome exhibits no matter how large or small and remind members that insects common in some areas are rare in others. There is a valuable prize, the **Bradford Award**, for the best adult exhibit at the show. **We also hope that our younger members will exhibit and remind them that there are a number of generous awards and prizes for Junior exhibits of different age groups.**

Due to our need to allocate the space, it is essential that you book your exhibit space (we may not be able to put your exhibit on display if you turn up on the day without letting us know beforehand). Please complete the booking form overleaf, and returning it to me by Saturday 30th September. Passes to enter the exhibition before the opening time and details as to where to take your exhibit will be sent out about a week before the event. We ask you also to supply a **brief** note (either before or at the exhibition) about your exhibit to the Society for publication in the *Bulletin*. It would help the Registrar considerably if these could be supplied as MS text files (*.txt) on disc or by email, or even within the body text of an email if attachments are a problem – registrar@amentsoc.org

Those members wishing to sell surplus material may either use the **Wants and Exchange table**, in which part of the monies (10%) will go to the Society's funds, or more if the member wishes, or members may book a sales table unit (details overleaf). If you need any further details, please feel free to contact us.

The sale of specimens protected by the Wildlife and Countryside Act and CITES is illegal without the appropriate licences and/or the relevant paperwork. Any suspicious circumstances will be reported to the appropriate authorities who will take further action. Any suspicious incidents concerning protected species should be reported to a steward immediately.
