

# The Amateur Entomologists' Society Trading Certificate



All traders selling livestock/deadstock should complete and return this document to the AES Exhibition Secretary no later than 15<sup>th</sup> September 2008.

This document lists those species which are covered by legislation and therefore have restrictions concerning their trade in any circumstances, not just at the AES Exhibition.

The list is the same as last year. However, approximately 100 species were added to the list last year so please make sure you review the list thoroughly.

We would also like to remind all traders that we require caresheets to be available for ALL species that are sold. We have noticed that some traders have failed to provide these when asked at the last Kempton exhibition. We will be checking again this year  
We will be requiring traders to remove livestock from sale if a caresheet is not provided.

Sale of Species Protected by Law

The AES is required to uphold the law when providing facilities for trade at its Annual Exhibition and elsewhere. The sale of every species listed below is restricted by law; i.e. the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (WCA) for native species<sup>1</sup>, and the EU Habitats Directive or CITES<sup>2</sup> for mostly non-native species on international lists. **If you intend to offer or display for sale any specimens of any of the listed species at the Exhibition, whether living or dead, you must do the following:**

1. Obtain all the necessary **licence(s), export/import permits or trading certificate(s)**.
2. Fill in this trading certificate to as show –
  - a. Which, if any, of the listed species you intend to offer for sale
  - b. Any specimens (e.g. captive-bred<sup>3</sup> livestock of a species listed in Appendix II of CITES) for which you are claiming exemption from the need to have a licence or other documentation
  - c. The licence-number(s) (or permit / certificate number(s) in the case of CITES species).
3. Send this certificate, completed and signed, to the relevant officer (e.g. Exhibition Secretary or Wants and Exchange editor).
4. At the exhibition, please be **ready to show on request all the relevant licences, permits, certificates or official letters** which prove that you are allowed to sell the specimens concerned. Also, space allowing, please **display all these documents prominently** next to the specimens concerned. You **must display at least the number(s)** of the licence(s), certificates or permits and you **must also label the specimen(s)** so as to show which ones are licensed or otherwise certified. All captive-bred<sup>3</sup> specimens should be labelled as such.

**NB. Vertebrate species, irrespective of their legal status, must not be traded in any way at the AES Exhibition**

**Failure to comply with ALL the above conditions will lead to action by our stewards and perhaps by the authorities. You would, at the very least, be asked to remove specimens from sale if you were unable to show relevant documents and you could be required to cease trading and to leave the exhibition immediately. If the law clearly appears to have been broken, the authorities may have to be informed.**

Various laws in the UK restrict trade in specified invertebrate species. The following table summarises the licensing requirements in England, where the AES currently holds its exhibitions. The table is not necessarily comprehensive and must be treated only as a guide. **Also, please observe the AES trading policy regarding venomous species.** If in doubt, consult the relevant authorities.

**NOTES**

- ♣ For CITES Appendix I species and for *Pamassius apollo*, a fresh trading certificate is required for each successive transfer of the specimen(s). The authorities rarely permit the sale of these species but if you have such permission, please enter the details using the blank lines at the end of the species-table below.
- ♠ Written proof will usually consist of import and export permit(s) or the original importer's signed notification of the permit numbers. For specimens captive-bred<sup>3</sup> in the UK, the AES requires only that they are **clearly labelled** as such.
- ϕ This applies only to specimens obtained from the wild in the European Union after 10<sup>th</sup> June 1994 (or the date of the individual EU nation's accession date, if later).

<sup>1</sup> Please note that the WCA 1981 applies to specimens of a foreign origin as well as to those from Great Britain.

<sup>2</sup> Within the UK, species listed under CITES are covered by COTES [Control of Trade in Endangered Species (Enforcement) Regulations 1997.]

<sup>3</sup> Under UK law, 'captive-bred' means derived from parents which were **both** obtained legally.

<sup>6</sup> The sale of species on Sch. 5 of WCA 1981 is normally illegal without a licence, even for specimens obtained after the scheduling of the species concerned. If a licensing authority has, however, informed a trader that a licence is not required, the trader must display an official letter as evidence. For captive-bred<sup>3</sup> livestock of species on Appendix II of CITES (e.g. *Brachypelma spp.*), the trader may insert the year when he or she legally obtained the breeding colony, if unable to state exactly when the wild progenitors were taken.

<sup>7</sup> Two licences; one for WCA Sch. 5 and one for EU Habitats Directive Annex IV are needed for these spp.
